- 7. Police Report Chief Wally Layne In response to Commissioner Harrington's questions last month, 142 warnings for dogs on the beach were given this summer. One person was arrested. They gave 77 warnings for holes on the beach and tagged 46 items left on the beach. They closed OBW in the 300 block when the water was high. Speed limit on OBW past the pier has increased to 45mph.

A committee was formed to look at the Noise Ordinance but now there are questions about who is on the committee.
- 11. Town Manager's Report The storm caused issues with the sewer system. There was infiltration of the lines but Public Works was able to keep it operational. There were vacuum issues but it worked. Comments on the proposed terminal groin were due. The Beautification Club's project on the mainland side of the bridge must go before NCDOT in December, so construction has been pushed back. Odor control project at the Pavilion will be complete after Festival by the Sea.

- 13. Board of Commissioners' Comments Commissioner Young asked the status of the street lights on the east end. They are working to craft a custom solution to make everyone happy. She also has a concern about public perception of a spouse of a Commissioner chairing a public board.
