Dear Mr. Lane:

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is to widen SR 1116 Ocean Blvd./McCray St. by about 10' for a length of approximately 6.14 miles along Holden Beach in Brunswick County to accommodate proposed bicycle lanes. The roadway will be widened a total of 10' from the existing pavement width but will remain entirely within the existing right-of-way. The Ocean Erodible Area of Environmental Concern (AEC) intersects the proposed construction area in multiple locations throughout the length of the project. To construct the pavement widening for the proposed bicycle lanes, a trench will be dug approximately 5" in proposed areas of new pavement and will be filled with Aggregate Base Course (ABC). Approximately 1.5" of new asphalt surface course will be applied to the entire 30' roadway after the new pavement bed is constructed in the widened areas. Excavated material will likely not be desirable sand material and will be taken to NCDOT approved disposal sites. Sediment and erosion control measures will be installed along the project length in accordance with NCDOT design standards for sensitive watersheds.
